

## Agreement for Bridal Bouquet Preservation at Nicole Friedman Studio

Thank you for choosing me to preserve your bridal bouquet in resin! Before we proceed, I'd like to share a few details about the process:

1. **Timeline:** The preservation process takes time to ensure the best possible results. The drying stage typically lasts around 3 weeks, after which I'll reach out to discuss the layout and design details. The actual resin preservation process takes about 2 weeks. Altogether, you can expect your finished piece to be ready within approximately 2 months.

2. **Resin and Yellowing:** While I use high-quality, yellowing-resistant resin, all resin can develop a slight amber tint over time. To keep your preservation looking its best, avoid placing it in direct sunlight, as this can speed up any color changes.

3. **Flower Preservation:** Flowers naturally change in color and texture as they dry. I use silica gel to preserve them as closely as possible to their original look, but slight variations are part of the process.

4. **Handmade Craftsmanship:** I treat your bouquet with the utmost care, as if it were my own. However, since this is a handmade piece, it won't be "factory perfect." Small air bubbles may appear in the resin, but I take great care to minimize them by pouring in layers and using tools like a heat gun.
